Membership is open to those who have an interest in supporting and advancing nursing leadership.

Non-voting corporate membership is available to civic and corporate leaders who have demonstrated a commitment to nursing and nursing leadership in Utah and who have goals consistent with the mission, vision and values of UONL.

Benefits of UONL Membership

UONL is committed to the development and support of existing and aspiring nurse leaders within Utah. Benefits include:

1. The responsibility and opportunity to participate in and contribute to our profession and to the advancement of health care in Utah and world wide.
2. The opportunity to network with and learn from nurse colleagues in Utah and the region. Participate in coalitions providing a common and powerful voice around issues of shared concern regarding the delivery of patient care or scope of practice.
3. The opportunity to attend educational programs, retreats and regional events at discounted tuition rates and receive continuing education credits.
4. The opportunity to mentor others and to be mentored while building a sustaining network of professional colleagues that expands beyond the employment setting.
5. Join with nurse leaders from academia and healthcare to improve education in the nursing profession.

Membership Categories

Full Membership - \$100/year

A full Member is a nurse who holds:

- The highest level management position(s) in a health care institution or system.
- A line management position with operational responsibilities including patient care and human resource management. This individual may be at the first line management level.
- A position within the health care institution/system with responsibility for specialized administrative duties, but who does not necessarily have accountability for the leadership of a patient

care unit. This could be a case manager or a director for administrative services.

- A position which interfaces with nurses in direct management by providing consultation of staff services. This could be a Clinical Nurse Specialist, a Nursing Consultant, a Nurse Educator, a Director of Nursing Research, or a leader in a nursing agency.

Academic Membership - \$100/year

An Academic Member is a nurse faculty member at an accredited educational program who is either in a leadership role in his/her institution or is involved in educating nurses for leadership positions.

Retired Membership - \$60/year

Retired Members are those who have been a past member of UONL and are now retired from practice.

Graduate Membership - \$50/year

A Graduate Member is a nurse who is currently enrolled (at least half-time) in a graduate education program designed for leadership in the health care industry.

Corporate Membership - \$200/year

A Corporate Member is a business or institution which is interested in current nursing and health care advancements. This membership is non-voting.
