ROSENVALL TO LEAD STATE HOSPITAL ASSOCIATION

Greg M. Rosenvall, Chief Executive Officer of Gunnison Valley Hospital, has been elected to serve as Chair of the Board of Trustees of the Utah Hospitals and Health Systems Association (UHA).
